## Record prize money set to exceed £1.6 million with investment at all levels



### New £200k Sky Bet Sunday Series Raceday

Featuring a **£200,000** prize fund, our new Sky Bet Sunday Series fixture on Sunday 8 May is set to be Hamilton Park's richest raceday ever. This fixture will be broadcast live on ITV4 and will feature a card full of high-value Class 3 and Class 4 races, designed to showcase horses, trainers and jockeys who don't often get the limelight.



### Record prize money for the Listed EBF Glasgow Stakes

Hamilton Park's highest-grade race of the season is the Listed EBF Glasgow Stakes, with notable former winners such as Postponed, Defoe and Subjectivist all going on to succeed at Group level. This year's renewal, on Friday 15 July, will be run for a record prize fund of **£55,250** and is sure to attract some of the highest rated horses in the country.

### Lanark Silver Bell upgraded to a Heritage Handicap

The race for the historic Lanark Silver Bell, believed by many to be the oldest sporting trophy in the world, has become a highlight of the Hamilton Park calendar. On Friday 26 August we will see our ambitions realised as we upgrade the race to a Heritage Handicap with prize money of **£100,000**.

This will make it our richest race ever, and gives connections the chance to have their names etched in history as well as on the new Lanark Silver Bell Trophy.

- Veterinary services provided by leading vets from **Weipers Centre Equine Hospital (University of Glasgow)**, **The Dick Vet Equine Hospital (University of Edinburgh)** and **Avondale Veterinary Group**.
- **Endoscopy** service available subject to pre-payment at the Racecourse Office. Please note priority will be given to horses requiring emergency First Aid.
- If required, referral and transfer services are available directly to the industry-leading Weipers Centre Equine Hospital, only 18 miles away.
